

PRINCE2® Introduction

OVERVIEW

This course aims to provide project team members in organisations with an overview of the PRINCE2 methodology. The aim of the course is to familiarize team members with the basic PRINCE2 concepts including: Components, Techniques and Processes. On completion of the course, management will be able to be an effective member of a PRINCE2 project.

The course can be used as a basis for more detailed study of the PRINCE2 method through other courses.

PRINCE2 is a method for managing projects and the course clarifies the impact on management involved in PRINCE2 projects. Structured project management means managing the project in a logical, organised way, following defined steps. A structured project management method is the written description of this logical, organised approach, PRINCE2 (projects in a controlled environment) is a structured project management method.

The method helps management establish who should be involved and what they will be responsible for. It gives a set of processes to work through and explains what information to be gathering along the way. Good projects, which deliver quality results, on-time and within budget are dependent on the capability of people involved from Project Board to individual members.
