

PRINCE2[®]:2009 PRACTITIONER COURSE

OVERVIEW

This project management course is aimed at measuring a delegate's ability to apply PRINCE2 to the running and managing of a project within an environment supporting PRINCE2.

Delegates need to exhibit the competence required for the Foundation qualification, and show that they can apply and tune PRINCE2 to address the needs and problems of a specific project scenario.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This project management course will benefit all those involved in PRINCE2 projects, including:

- Project Managers
- General Managers
- Programme Managers
- Team Managers & Support Staff
- Staff who will have a defined role
- Project Management Consultants

PRE-REQUISITE LEARNING

All delegates must have successfully completed the PRINCE2 Foundation exam.

Delegates who successfully complete the Practitioner exam are encouraged to pursue Managing Successful Programmes Foundation and Practitioner accreditation.

COURSE CONTENT

A review of the Principles, Themes, Processes and Techniques of the PRINCE2 method, consolidating understanding and addressing any areas of concern that may arise.

COURSE DURATION & DELIVERY

This is an intensive two day course leading to the PRINCE2 Practitioner examination which takes place on the final day.

The PRINCE2 Practitioner Objective Test Exam (OTE) is a multiple choice two and a half hour exam. Delegates are presented with 9 questions worth 12 marks each. Delegates must obtain 55% out of the 108 available marks. This examination is open-book allowing only for the PRINCE2 Manual to be taken into the examination.

Delegates receive a PRINCE2 manual and evening work is also required during the course.

The project management course is presented by APM Group accredited trainers in a highly interactive environment. Presentations and discussions are intermingled with delegates completing and marking a previous Practitioner paper.

The project management course may be delivered at our premises or alternatively we also tailor the course to be delivered in-house with adequate attendees.

Upon course completion delegates will be able to:

- ✓ Produce detailed explanations of all processes, components and techniques, and worked examples of all PRINCE2 products as applied to address the particular circumstances of a given project scenario.

- ✓ Demonstrate that they understand the reasons behind the processes, components and techniques of PRINCE2, and that they understand the principles underpinning these elements.
- ✓ Demonstrate their ability to tune PRINCE2 to different project circumstances.
